

Chillida Leku – important information

Access and parking for Txikijazz concerts (Claire Martin Quartet, Arima Soul):

Tickets for the concert include entry to the museum, its exhibitions, picnic area and workshop. The museum doors open at 10:00. The workshop starts at 11:00 and the concert is at 12:30.

Those coming by private vehicle must park in Galarreta. A free shuttle bus will run from there to the museum between 10:30 and 12:30, returning to Galarreta between 14:00 and 15:00.

Access and parking for the open-air concerts beginning at 19:30 (Bascolombia, Iñaki Salvador/Marco Mezquida: *Dichosos tributos*):

The tickets for these concerts give their holders right of access to the Museum throughout the same day and we recommend you to arrive at least 40 minutes in advance, which will begin at 19:30.

If you come driving, the vehicles will be redirected to the Galarreta car park. A free shuttle service will be provided from Galarreta to the Museum from 18:30 to 19:30, returning till 22:00.

Access and parking for the concerts in the Zabalaga country house beginning at 19:30 (Lew Tabackin Quartet, Jordina Millà & Barry Guy)

The tickets for these concerts give their holders right of access to the Museum throughout the same day and we recommend you to arrive at least 40 minutes in advance, which will begin at 19:30.

If you arrive at the concert in a private vehicle, you can leave it in the museum car park.

Clothing, footwear and other recommendations:

We remind you that during open-air events the temperature may rise or fall, so we recommend that you wear suitable clothing, a hat, sunscreen and comfortable shoes to move around the museum fields.

We also recommend that you bring a blanket or mat on which to watch the concert comfortably; a limited number of folding seats will also be available for attendees, distributed in order of arrival.

Assistance dogs:

Support dogs (guide, hearing, medical alert, accompanying persons with autism, providing service to those with reduced mobility, etc.) are welcome, according to LAW 10/2007, of 20 June, on Assistance Dogs providing Attention to Persons with Disability. No other kind of dogs, or other animals, are allowed.
