

## CONDITIONS FOR BRINGING DOGS TO THE JAZZALDIA

Bringing dogs to the JAZZALDIA is conditioned by the requirements and regulations of the different spaces occupied by the Festival stages. These spaces may be public (governed by the "Municipal law on the protection and possession of animals in Donostia San Sebastian" issued by the City Council of Donostia San Sebastian) or private (in which case there are also existing regulations on occupation and coexistence which must be observed):

### - Stages in private venues:

The presence of dogs in multi-purpose cultural installations and private venues is forbidden, except for assistance dogs (guide, signal, medical alert, autism, service dogs for people with reduced mobility, etc.), in accordance with law 10/2007, of 29 June, on Assistance Dogs for the Care of People with Disabilities guide dogs. Thus, generally speaking, accompanying dogs will not be allowed into the:

- Kursaal Auditorioa (to attend with guide dogs, a specific ticket for "people with reduced mobility – row 17" must be acquired).
- Victoria Eugenia Antzokia
- San Telmo Museoa
- Kutxa Kultur Tabakalera

### - Regulated closed stage:

Stages of this kind are subject to the same regulations as private cultural spaces, meaning that dogs are not allowed (with the exception of assistance dogs).

- Trinitate Plaza

### - Open air stages in the urban public space:

Under municipal law, the presence of dogs is allowed. In the case of the JAZZALDIA, the presence of animals during concerts is subject to rules of a hygienic-sanitary nature and of coexistence (in other words, dogs will be allowed provided that their behaviour does not affect normal development of the event). The animal must be on a leash and must neither urinate nor defecate in the area of the event.
